**Mission:** The Kalra Family Foundation seeks to recognize and award students of upstanding character who actively unite and enhance Hillsborough High School's unique community. Specifically, the scholarship is intended for students who demonstrate altruism, inclusivity, and insight and are often overlooked by conventional criteria.

**Scholarships: \$1,000 cash scholarship**. Deserving students can invest in themselves however they wish; receipts and reimbursements will not be necessary. The selection committee aims to select a total of six students, three IB and three traditional, who exemplify humanitarianism, leadership, and intelligence.

## Eligibility:

- o Graduating Hillsborough High School seniors
- o Minimum 2.5 GPA (unweighted)
- o Accepted into an accredited college/university/vocational school
- o Legal U.S. resident

**Selection:** A selection committee of Hillsborough High School teachers will review completed applications and present top nominees to the Kalra Family Foundation for confirmation. Applications are confidential. Partial and late applications will not be accepted.

Selected candidates will be asked to submit a portrait photo with short bio for online publication. Scholarship awards will be given as checks to individual students at a presentation. Inability to attend this presentation may result in award cancellation. Recipients will be asked to write a paragraph after being awarded the scholarship on their feelings about being selected and how they intend to use the funds.
